

Canopy Stripe Triple Fold Wrap

Sizes

xs (32-34")

s (36-38")

m (40-42")

l (44-46")

xl (48-50")

Modified to correct needle size on 6/29

Yarn

- 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) Canopy Fingering by The Fibre Company (50% Baby Alpaca, 30% Merino, 20% Bamboo), 50 g, 200yd/183m **each** in colors Obsidian (MC) and Sarsaparilla (CC)

Notes:

1) Yarn Substitutions: Use a yarn and needle size combination that results in a fabric with drape.

2) Just over 2 skeins of each color was used for the XS.

Needles

- one US #5 (3.75mm) circular needle at least 32"
or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions

- needle for weaving in ends
- locking stitch markers or safety pins (approximately 20)

Finished Measurements

flat measurements (knit piece laid flat with unsewn seams)

lower body

width: 43 (47, 51, 55, 59)"

length: 9.25 (10.75, 12.0, 13.25, 14.75)"

upper body/sleeves

width: 43 (47, 51, 55, 59)"

length: 9.25 (10.75, 12.0, 13.25, 14.75)"

collar

width: 43 (47, 51, 55, 59)"

length: 5.5 (6.5, 7.25, 8.0, 8.75)"

sleeve length: 8 (9, 10, 12, 12)"

width across back from underarms: 27 (29, 31, 31, 35)"

The width across the back is the most important measurement for the fit of the garment. This measurement should be greater than the actual measurement across the back between the underarms.

size shown: xs

Gauge

5 sts = 1" and 7.5 rows = 1" in St st
20 sts = 4" and 30" rows = 4" in St st

Gauge is based on measurements after lightly steaming knit piece.

Rev St st

Row 1 (WS): knit
Row 2 (RS): purl

It is recommended to use the Backward Loop Cast On for casting on stitches for the sleeves and collar.

Lower Body

CO on 215 (235, 255, 275, 295) sts with the Long Tail Cast On with MC.

Purl 1st row.

Work 14 (16, 18, 20, 22) more rows in Rev St st with MC.

Change to CC and work 14 (16, 18, 20, 22) rows in Rev St st.

Continue to work in Rev St st alternating colors every 14 (16, 18, 20, 22) rows until 5 color bands have been knit (3 in MC and 2 in CC).

Piece should measure approximately 9.25 (10.75, 12.0, 13.25, 14.75)" from bottom CO edge.

Upper Body/ Sleeves

Begin Sleeves

Row 1: BO 40 (45, 50, 60, 60) sts, at beg of row, k across remaining sts with CC.

Row 2: BO 40 (45, 50, 60, 60) sts at beg of row, p across remaining sts. 135 (145, 155, 155, 175) sts

Row 3: CO 40 (45, 50, 60, 60) sts at beg of row, k across all sts.

Row 4: CO 40 (45, 50, 60, 60) sts at beg of row, p across all sts ending with 215 (235, 255, 275, 295) sts,

Continue to work in Rev St st alternating colors every 14 (16, 18, 20, 22) rows until 5 color bands have been knit (2 in MC and 3 in CC).

Piece should measure approximately 18.75 (21.25, 24.0, 26.75, 29.25)" from CO edge.

Collar

Row 1: BO 40 (45, 50, 60, 60) sts, at beg of row, k across remaining sts with MC.

Row 2: BO 40 (45, 50, 60, 60) sts at beg of row, p across remaining sts. 135 (145, 155, 155, 175) sts


Row 3: CO 40 (45, 50, 60, 60) sts at beg of row, k across all sts.

Row 4: CO 40 (45, 50, 60, 60) sts at beg of row, p across all sts. 215 (235, 255, 275, 295) sts

Continue to work in Rev St st alternating colors every 14 (16, 18, 20, 22) rows until 3 color bands have been knit (2 in MC and 1 in CC).

Piece should measure approximately 24.25 (27.75, 31.25, 34.75, 38.0)" from bottom CO edge.

BO all sts.



Finishing

Lay piece flat so WS is facing up and RS is facing down.

Fold sleeves in half and line up the CO and BO edges of the sleeves. Pin sleeve seams together. Sew sleeve seams using mattress stitch. Next with sleeves folded in half, pin the CO edge of collar to BO edge of lower body on each side of garment. Sew body and collar seams using mattress stitch.

Weave in ends.
